1. Roll Call

Matt Steer(President), Tom Slatter (Secretary), Ol Gunawan (Treasurer), Steve Millington (UCESTBA Secretary) and representatives from Sheffield, Warwick, Portsmouth, Leeds, Liverpool, Aston, Birmingham, Manchester, UEA, Nottingham, London, Loughborough, Essex, Nottingham Trent and Hull.

2. Apologies

Apologies were received from Southampton, Newcastle and Kent. It was deemed necessary to fine Newcastle (£25) and Kent (£50). Apologies were also received from Tony Quinn, tournament co llator.

3. Approval of End of Season Meeting

The end of season meeting minutes were deemed to be accurate.

4. Discussion of 2001/2002 Tournament Calendar

After some difficulties over the Summer the details of the Nottingham tournament were finalised with the Nottingham Tournament Sec running the day. The tournament calendar was discussed at length and the final calendar can be seen on the website.

The O.O.M. is to remain the same with captains nominating possible Masters candidates to Tony Quinn.

5. Championship 2001/2002

As requested at the EoSM 2001 the Championship Finals have been arranged for 9th March 2002 at Nuneaton.

The format of the Championship is to remain the same with five groups of 3 clubs. Exeter and Leeds have withdrawn from the Ch ampionship. Nottingham Trent and Nottingham have become tied clubs as have Aston/Birmingham.

6. Constitutional and G.S.O. Matters

.Changes and/or deletions as follows:

Section 4.3 Replace '20hrs per week for at least 20 weeks per year' with '60 credits or equivalent per year'

Section 4.3.1 (New section) Insert 'To establish student status a captain can demand presentation of any of the opposing teams proof of student status (a union card or a stamped certificate from their university). Should this not be possible the player in question may bowl and the proof of student status made available to the Executive within seven days. If satisfactory proof is not received in this time the player in question's scores for any matches bowled shall become zero.'

Section 4.7 Replace 'three' with 'six'.

Section 4.8 Replace entirely with 'During any one season, each UCTBA Member Club can register up to six honorary members. For any UCTBA Championship match up to four of the six registered honorary members can play in the club team. For UCTBA Tournaments all six can play for the club they are registered with.'
