Entry Allocations

The allocation of entries is on an 'equal entitlement' basis. Each club submitting an entry by the closing date will initially receive one place. Each club requesting more than one team will then be allocated an additional place. This process will continue until the number of places exceeds the number of clubs requesting extra teams; these remaining places will be allocated on a 'first come first served' basis, with the Tournament Treasurer's decision being final.

Practice Rules

There will be five minutes practice before the start of the event.
There will also be a 'warm up' pair of lanes for the incoming players use only.

Lane Allocations

Upon registration, teams will be given a code number via random draw.

Rules and Regulations

- This event will be a Double Diamond Fours (Handicapped) event for students only.
- Mixed teams from different B.U.T.B.A. Member clubs will not be permitted.
- The tournament will carry a B.T.B.A. Support Sanction (Sanction Number: XXXXXXXXXX). B.T.B.A. Members will be eligible for B.T.B.A. services, and anyone wishing to join the B.T.B.A. on the day will be able to do so (the membership fee for the 2014/15 season is £25).
- The tournament will be bowled at The Chesterfield Bowl, Storch Lane, Chesterfield, Derbyshire, S40 2TU (01246 550092) on Sunday 29th March 2015. Registration will open 45 minutes before the first squad, and will close 15 minutes before the squad starts.
- The tournament will be played under the auspices of B.U.T.B.A. and in accordance with B.U.T.B.A. Rules, Regulations and Standing Orders, in particular;
 - The tournament will be played under the general playing rules and regulations of the B.T.B.A.
 - All handicaps will be based on 100% of the difference between the competitor's entering average and 220.
 - Averages must be taken from the B.U.T.B.A. tour average 2014/15 over a minimum of 12 games. Where no such average exists, rule TPN 40 applies.
 - Proof of any entering average must be provided at registration. Those competitors without a proven average will only be allowed to compete with a handicap of zero.
 - There is no maximum handicap.
- The Tournament Director will be Louise Parker, whose decision on the day will be final, subject to appeal to the B.U.T.B.A. Executive or Council, or the B.T.B.A.
- The Tournament Secretary will be Rachael McKenzie, who shall be responsible for the pre-tournament organisation.
- The Tournament Treasurer reserves the right to accept or refuse any entry. Late entries will also be accepted only at the Tournament Treasurer's discretion. The Tournament Treasurer will be Craig Harmon.**
- The entry fee will be £116 per team (i.e. £29 per person). For each competitor, this includes a prize fund of £5 (which will be returned 100% in tournament prizes), a donation of £1 towards the Team England Fund, 50p contribution to the Order of Merit Fund, 75p contribution to the Club Development Fund, and a 75p contribution towards the Masters Fund. Tournament Format

A team consists of four bowlers who will each play 8 games. Teams must specify the order in which they will bowl in the entry form below, or at latest at registration, designating each player as either Bowler 1 (B1), Bowler 2 (B2), Bowler 3 (B3) or Bowler 4 (B4). Play will then commence as indicated in the diagram below.

The winners will be the team with the highest handicap pinfall over 32 games.
