Entry Allocations

The allocation of entries is on an 'equal entitlement' basis. Each club submitting an entry by the closing date shall initially receive one place. Each club requesting more than one team will then be allocated an additional place. This process will continue until the number of places left exceeds the number of clubs requesting extra teams; these remaining places will be allocated on a 'first come first served' basis, with the Tournament Treasurer's decision being final.

Tournament Format

The tournament is a handicapped combination quads event with each team forming: two doubles, a trios and a single, and a four, such that each competitor bowls one doubles, trios OR singles and all team members bowling the fours. Each section will consist of a single 3-game block bowled on a pair of lanes, and each competitor will thus play 9 games total. The winner of each section will be the team subdivision with the highest handicapped pitfall total. In the event of a tie, the team subdivision with the highest handicap will be declared the winner. The overall competition winners will be the team with the highest pinfall accumulated over all sections. In the event of a tie for any of the placings, the team with the highest total handicap will be declared the winner.

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Tournament Rules and Regulations

- The tournament will be a Handicapped Combination Quads event for current students.
- The tournament will carry a B.T.B.A. Support Sanction (Sanction Number XXXXXXXXXX). B.T.B.A. members will be eligible for B.T.B.A. services, and anyone wishing to join on the day will be able to do so (cost for the 2014/15 season is £25).
- The tournament will be bowled at the MFA Bowl Sheffield, Sicey Avenue, Firth Park, Sheffield, S5 6NF, (0114) 2561020 on Saturday 21st February 2015. Registration will open 45 minutes before the first squad, and will close 15 minutes before the squad starts.
- The tournament will be played under the auspices of B.U.T.B.A. and in accordance with the B.U.T.B.A. Rules, Regulations and Standing Orders, in particular:
 - The tournament will be played under the general playing rules and regulations of the B.T.B.A.
 - All handicaps will be based on 100% of the difference between the competitor's entering average and 220.
 - Averages must be taken from the B.U.T.B.A. Tour Average 2014/15 over a minimum of 12 games. Where no such average exists, rule TPN40 applies.
 - Proof of any entering average must be provided at registration. Those competitors without a proven average will only be allowed to compete with zero handicap.
 - There is no maximum handicap.
- The Tournament Director will be **Tom Andrews**, whose decision on the day will be final, subject to appeal to the B.U.T.B.A. Executive Council, or the B.T.B.A.
- The Tournament Secretary will be **Carl Whitfield** who shall be responsible for the pre-tournament organisation.

7. The tournament Treasurer reserved the right to accept or refuse any entry. Late entries are also only accepted at the Tournament Treasurer's discretion. The Tournament Treasurer will be **Craig Harmon**.

8. The entry fee will be £128 per team (i.e. £32 per person). For each competitor this includes a fund of £5.50 (which will be returned 100% in tournament prizes), a donation of £1 towards the Team England Fund, 50p to the Order of Merit Fund, 75p contribution to the Club Development Fund and 75p contribution towards the Masters Fund. The tournament contributes to the Order of Merit 2014/15. If paying via BACS please contact the Tournament Treasurer.
