Tournament Format

The tournament is a matchplay handicapped trios event. The first round will see teams allocated into groups (2 groups of 7 teams, based on an entry of 14 teams), who will then play each other team in their group over a single game, Peterson Points system, 1 point per player and 6 points per team based on handicapped pinfall. The top 4 teams in each group will progress to the finals.

Quarter Finals: The draw is split with X1 v Y4, X2 v Y3 on one side and X3 v Y2, X4 v Y1 on the other. Winner progress to the semi finals. Each semi final winner progresses to the final, each losing semi finalist will contest the 3rd/4th place match.

Entry Allocations

The allocation of entries is on a 'first come, first served' basis, with the Tournament Treasurer's discretion being final.

Rules and Regulations

1. This event will be a Peterson Points Matchplay Trios (Handicapped) event for Ex-Students only.
2. The tournament will carry a B.T.B.A. Support Sanction (Sanction Number: XXXXXXXXXX). B.T.B.A. members will be eligible for B.T.B.A. services, and anyone wishing to join on the day will be able to do so (cost for the 2014/2015 season is £25).
3. The tournament will be bowled at Airport Bowl, Bath Road, Harlington, Middlesex, UB3 5AL (020 8759 7246) on Saturday 9th May 2015. Registration will open 45 minutes before the first squad, and will close 15 minutes before the squad starts.
4. The tournament will be played under the auspices of B.U.T.B.A. and in accordance with the B.U.T.B.A. Rules, Regulations and Standing Orders, in particular:
 - i. The tournament will be played under the general playing rules and regulations of the B.T.B.A.
 - ii. All handicaps will be based on 100% of the difference between the competitor's entering average and 220.
 - iii. Averages must be taken from the B.U.T.B.A. tour average 2014/2015 over a minimum of 12 games. Where no such average exists, rule TPN 40 applies.
 - iv. Proof of any entering average must be provided at registration. Those competitors without a proven average will only be allowed to compete zero handicap.
 - v. There is no maximum handicap.
5. The Tournament Director will be Shaun Parsons, whose decision on the day will be final, subject to appeal to the B.U.T.B.A. Executive or Council, or the B.T.B.A.
6. The Tournament Secretary will be Tim Hughes, who shall be responsible for the pre-tournament organisation.
7. **The Tournament Treasurer reserves the right to accept or refuse any entry. Late entries are also accepted only at the Tournament Treasurer's discretion. The Tournament Treasurer will be Craig Harmon.**
8. **The entry fee will be £84 per team (i.e. £28 per person). For each competitor, this includes a prize fund of £5 (which will be returned 100% in tournament prizes), a donation of £1 towards the Team England Fund, 50p to the Order of Merit Fund, 75p contribution to the Club Development Fund, and 75p contribution towards the Masters Fund. 9. The closing date for entries is Saturday 25th April 2015.
10. The tournament contributes to the Rankings 2014/2015.

Practice Rules

There will be five minutes practice for everyone in the first game, those not in the final game (and those subsequently sitting out) will be entitled to use the practice lanes.

Lane Allocations

Upon registration, teams will be given a code number on initial squad time, via a random draw: this will determine their allocated group for the first round.
