Tournament Rules & Regulations

- 1) The tournament will NOT be sanctioned.
- 2) The tournament will be a scratch and handicapped singles event for current ex-students.
- 3) The tournament will be bowled at MFA Bowl, Unit 1, Everoak Estate, Bromyard Road, Worcester, WR2 5HN on Sunday, 13 November 2016.
- 4) Tournament registration will open at 09:15 and will close 15 minutes before the first squad starts.
- 5) The tournament will be played under the auspices of BUTBA and in accordance with the BUTBA rules, regulations and standing orders, in particular:
 - i) The tournament will be played under the general playing rules and regulations of the BTBA.
 - ii) Proof of any entering average must be provided at registration (current BUTBA averages will be available on the day).
 - iii) Averages must be taken from the 2015/16 BUTBA tour (over a minimum of 12 games). Where no such average exists, [RNK 14](#) applies.
 - iv) There is no maximum handicap.
 - v) Late arrivals before the end of the 5th frame of a game will be permitted to catch up that game from frame 1. Arrivals after the end of the 5th frame will not be permitted to bowl that game and a blind score in accordance with vi) will be entered for that game.
 - vi) A blind score of 150 scratch plus 50 handicap, *may* be awarded to absent players, at the tournament director's discretion.
- 6) The tournament director's decision on the day will be final, subject to appeal to the BUTBA Executive or council.
- 7) The tournament secretary shall be responsible for any pre-tournament organisation.
- 8) The tournament treasurer reserves the right to accept or refuse any entry. Late entries are accepted at the tournament director's discretion.
- 9) The entry fee will be £40.00 per team (£40.00 per person). For each competitor, this includes a prize fund of £15.83 (which will be returned 100% in tournament prizes), a donation of £1.00 to the Ranking fund, £0.50 to the Masters fund and £1.00 to the Club Development fund.

Tournament Format

Every bowler bowls 6 games at doubles pace, moving lanes after every single game. At the end of qualification every bowler is ranked based on both their total scratch and total handicapped pinfall. The 6 top players on scratch pinfall progress to a Scratch Round Robin Final, whilst the 6 best players from the remainder on total handicapped pinfall, will progress to the Handicap Round Robin Final. In the event of a tie for any position, the player with the highest last game will place highest, if this is also tied then we'll compare the second last games and so on.

In the round robin stages, pinfall does NOT carry forward, and there are NO pinfall bonuses for winning matches or hitting high games, instead in both sections, there will be 2 points awarded for any match won, 1 point for any match drawn and 0 points for a loss.

The bowler with the most points at the end of each round robin will be declared the winner. In the event of a tie for any position the bowler with the highest total pinfall over the course of the Round Robin will place above the rest. If pinfall is also tied, then the bowler with the highest last game will receive the higher placing, and if this is also tied, the bowlers will play a 2 frame roll-off (9th & 10th) to determine who wins the prize. (If this occurs in the handicap section, the bowlers will each receive 20% of their handicap!).

Lane Allocations

Upon registration, bowlers will be given a code number via a random draw. This will determine their allocated lane.

Practice Rules

There will be 10 minutes practice at the start of the event, 5 minutes practice after the re-oil for all qualifiers and no subsequent practice.

Prizes

Prizes will be awarded as follows (based on a 24 team entry):

Scratch Winner	£100
Scratch Runner-up	£60
Handicap Winner	£100
Handicap Runner-up	£60
High Scratch Game (Male)	£10
High Scratch Game (Female)	£10
High Handicap Game	£10
High Scratch Average (Male)	£10
High Scratch Average (Female)	£10
Most Improved (High Handicap Average)	£10

N.B. For any individual award category covering both scratch and handicapped scores (i.e. high game or series), a competitor may not receive both awards. The award for the scratch prize takes precedence. In the event of a tie for any scratch or handicap award, the prize will be shared between the competitors concerned.

N.B.2. High game and high average awards will consider all games played throughout the tournament and not just the qualifying stages.
