Lane Allocations

Upon registration, bowlers will be given a code number via a random draw. This will determine their allocated lane.

Practice Rules

There will be 5 minutes practice at the start of the tournament for all players designated number 1 in their respective teams, and 5 minutes practice for incoming bowlers for the doubles and trios. There there will be 10 minutes practice after the reoil for all players designated numbers 2 and 3 in their respective teams, and no subsequent practice. There will also be a practice pair of lanes available for all incoming bowlers to use before bowling in the tournament.

Prizes

The award for the scratch prize takes precedence. In the event of a tie for any scratch or handicap award, the prize will be shared between the competitors concerned.

N.B.2. High game and high average awards will consider all games played throughout the tournament and not just the qualifying stages.
